

RESOLUTION 425

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland, Washington as follows:

THAT WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Kirkland, together with the Planning Commission of the City of Kirkland have fully considered the pending disposition of the war housing project in the City of Kirkland known as Kirkland Heights A,

And the City Council having considered the substandard type of said housing, the character of occupancy and the need therefor, and the various possible uses of the units and the property on which they are located, does hereby adopt the following positions:

The City Council having considered the proposed subdivision and platting of said A Project for on-site sale states that they would refuse to accept platting and street dedications in A Project, because of substandard conditions of housing, lot sizes, utility standards serving the project and street conditions.

It is the recommendation of the City Council that A Project be classified as temporary and that the government dispose by off-site sale of the project.

It is the recommendation of the City Council that negotiations be entered into by the Federal Government for possible purchase of the property by the City of Kirkland for municipal purposes.
