

## RESOLUTION 426

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland, Washington as follows:

THAT WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Kirkland, has fully considered the problem of traffic parking and signals on Lake Street and Lake Street South in the City of Kirkland and in an effort to expedite traffic on said street it is proposed:

That the State Highway Commission be requested to approve a No Parking restriction on the east side of Lake Street and Lake Street South in the City of Kirkland from Second Avenue South to Central Way between the hours of four (4) to six (6) P. M., and that there be free right turns for north bound traffic on Lake Street South and Lake Street at Kirkland Avenue and Commercial Avenue intersections.

The foregoing resolutions considered and passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of July, 1954.
