

RESOLUTION NO. 433

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AS
FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS the City Council of the City of Kirkland, Washington has been notified by the Town of Houghton, Washington that a petition was filed with the Houghton Town Council seeking consolidation of the Town of Houghton and the City of Kirkland, and


WHEREAS the Houghton Town Council has designated Tuesday, July 12, 1955, as the date of a special election to be held to submit to the electors of Houghton and Kirkland the question whether the consolidation shall be executed.

And said petition further stated that in the event consolidation is effected, the name of the proposed new city shall be "Kirkland". Now, therefore,

The City Council of Kirkland hereby calls and gives notice of the special election to be held in the City of Kirkland simultaneously with the Town of Houghton on Tuesday, July 12, 1955, to submit to the electors the question of whether consolidation of the Town of Houghton and the City of Kirkland shall be effected and, if effected, the name of the new city to be Kirkland, and,

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED AND THE COUNCIL HEREBY DIRECTS that notice of said election be given according to law.
