BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND  
AS FOLLOWS:

THAT WHEREAS a Petition has been presented for the vacation  
of that certain alley described as follows:

That certain 16-foot alley running in a north-south  
direction in Block 233, Town of Kirkland, and further  
located as running between Lots 16 to 25 on the east  
and Lots 17 to 24 on the west, in King County, Washington.

AND WHEREAS, it appears desirable for the best interest of  
the city and the property owners concerned that said alley be vacated,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF KIRKLAND:

1. That a hearing should be had upon the proposed vacation  
of the following described alley property:


That certain 16-foot alley running in a north-south
