

RESOLUTION NO. 442

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That at a special election to be held on Tuesday, May 28, 1957, in the City of Kirkland, Washington and in the various precincts thereof, the following proposition and question shall be voted upon by the qualified voters or electors of said City, to-wit:

PROPOSITION: Shall the City Council of the City of Kirkland be authorized to levy a special property tax in the year 1957, for receipt in the year 1958, in the approximate amount of five mills, sufficient to raise the sum of \$27,850.00, to be paid into the street fund of the City of Kirkland for the purpose of applying road mix, seal coating, or hot mix (asphaltic concrete) as may be required and desirable on the streets and avenues of the City of Kirkland, said millage being in excess of any constitutional or statutory authority?


