

RESOLUTION NO. 446

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND
AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That at a special election to be held on Tuesday,
March 11, 1958 in the City of Kirkland, Washington and in the various
precincts thereof, the following proposition and question shall be
voted upon by the qualified voters or electors of said city, to-wit:

PROPOSITION: EXCESS LEVY FOR STREET IMPROVEMENTS.

Shall the City Council of the City of Kirkland be
authorized to levy a special property tax in the year 1958 for
receipt in the year 1959 in the approximate amount of five mills,
sufficient to raise the sum of \$28,950.00 to be paid into the street
fund of the City of Kirkland for the purpose of applying road mix,
seal coating, or hot mix (asphaltic concrete) as may be required
and desirable on the street and avenues of the City of Kirkland,
said millage being in excess of any constitutional or statutory
authority?


