

RESOLUTION NO. 448

A RESOLUTION of the City of Richland, Washington, calling for an election on the question of creating a metropolitan municipal corporation, describing the boundaries of such corporation, and naming the function which it shall be initially authorized to perform.

WHEREAS, there exists within the State of Washington a populous metropolitan area consisting of ten cities and towns, including the City of Seattle, a city of the first class, and an unincorporated portion of King County; and

WHEREAS, sewage disposal is an essential service not now adequately provided within the said area by existing agencies of local government; and

WHEREAS, this essential service can adequately be provided if King County and the cities and towns within the said area are able to act jointly to furnish such service; and

WHEREAS, the creation of a metropolitan municipal corporation as provided by Chapter 213, Laws of 1957, will make possible such joint action and will be conducive to the welfare and benefit of the persons and property within the said metropolitan area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Washington, as follows:

Section 1. Finding of Welfare and Benefit. It is hereby found and declared that the creation of a metropolitan municipal corporation as hereinafter provided within the metropolitan area described herein will be conducive to the welfare and benefit of the persons and property within the said metropolitan area.

Section 2. Election Called For. The Board of King County Commissioners is hereby requested to call an election on the question of authorizing the creation of a metropolitan municipal corporation pursuant to Chapter 213, Laws of 1957, within the metropolitan area described herein.

Section 3. When Election To Be Held. Such election shall be held on September 9, 1958, as a special election to be held in conjunction with the regular primary election on said date.

Section 4. Metropolitan Function. The metropolitan function which such corporation shall be initially authorized to perform shall be metropolitan sewage disposal.

Section 5. Boundary. The boundary of such metropolitan area and of the proposed metropolitan municipal corporation shall be as follows:

Beginning at the northwesterly corner of King County, Washington, being the intersection of the center of the channel known as Admiralty Inlet on Puget Sound with the township line between Township 26 North and Township 27 North, being the true point of beginning;

Thence easterly along said township line, being also the Snohomish-King County boundary line, to the northeast corner of Section 5, Township 26 North, Range 5 East W. M.;

Thence southerly along the east lines of Sections 5, 8 and 17 of Township 26 North, Range 5 East W. M., to the southeast corner of said Section 17, which is also the northwest corner of Section 21 of said township and range;

Thence easterly along the north line of said Section 21 to the northeast corner thereof;

Thence southerly along the east line of said Section 21 and continuing southerly along the east line of Section 28, Township 26 North, Range 5 East W. M., to the southeast corner thereof which is also the northwest corner of Section 34 of said township and range;

Thence easterly along the north line of said Section 34 to an intersection with the north-south centerline thereof;

Thence southerly along said centerline to the north line of Section 3, Township 25 North, Range 5 East W. M.;

Thence continuing southerly along the north-south centerlines of Sections 3, 10 and 15, Township 25 North, Range 5 East W. M., to an intersection with the north line of the south half of the NE 1/4 of said Section 15;

Thence easterly along said north line of the south half of the NE 1/4 of said Section 15 to the east line of said Section 15;

Thence southerly along the east lines of Sections 15 and 22 of said township and range to an intersection with the east-west centerline of said Section 22;

Thence easterly along the east-west centerlines of Sections 23 and 24, Township 25 North, Range 5 East W. M., to the east line of said Section 24;

Thence continuing easterly along the east-west centerline of Section 19, Township 25 North, Range 6 East W. M., to the westerly shore of Lake Sammamish;

Thence southerly along the west shore of Lake Sammamish to an intersection with the north line of Section 13, Township 24 North, Range 5 East W. M.;

Thence westerly along said north line to an intersection with the north-south centerline of said Section 13;

Thence southerly along the north-south centerlines of Sections 13 and 24, Township 24 North, Range 5 East W. M. to the northerly line of Section 25, Township 24 North, Range 5 East W. M.;

Thence westerly along the northerly line of Sections 25, 26 and 27 of said township and range to an intersection with the north-south centerline of said Section 27;

Thence southerly along the north-south centerlines of Sections 27 and 34, Township 24 North, Range 5 East W. M. to the northerly line of Section 3, Township 23 North, Range 5 East W. M.;

Thence continuing southerly along the north-south centerlines of Sections 3, 10, 15 and 22, Township 23 North, Range 5 East W. M. to an intersection with the northerly line of Section 27 of said township and range;

Thence westerly along the northerly line of Sections 27 and 28, Township 23 North, Range 5 East W. M. to the northeasterly corner of Section 29 of said township and range;

Thence southerly along the easterly line of said Section 29, Township 23 North, Range 5 East W. M. to an intersection with the east-west centerline of said Section 29;

Thence westerly along the east-west centerlines of Sections 29 and 30, Township 23 North, Range 5 East W. M. to the easterly line of Section 25, Township 23 North, Range 4 East W. M.;

Thence northerly along the easterly line of Sections 25 and 24, Township 23 North, Range 4 East W. M. to an intersection with the east-west centerline of said Section 24;

Thence westerly along said east-west centerline to an intersection with the north-south centerline of said Section 24, Township 23 North, Range 4 East W. M.;

Thence northerly along the north-south centerlines of Sections 24 and 13, Township 23 North, Range 4 East W. M. to the southerly line of Section 12 of said township and range;

Thence westerly along the southerly line of said Section 12 to the easterly line of Section 11, Township 23 North, Range 4 East W. M. which is also the southeast corner of said Section 11;

Thence northerly along said easterly line of Section 11 of said township and range to an intersection with the east-west centerline of said Section 11;

Thence westerly along the east-west centerlines of Sections 11 and 10, Township 23 North, Range 4 East W. M. to an intersection with the centerline of the Duwamish River or Waterway;

Thence downstream along the centerline of the Duwamish River or Waterway to an intersection with the city limits of Seattle (as of January 1, 1958);

Thence in a southerly and westerly direction along the city limits of Seattle (as of January 1, 1958) to the shore of Puget Sound and continuing southwesterly along said city limits to the center of the channel of East Passage (also known as Admiralty Inlet) on Puget Sound;

Thence in a northerly direction along said center of the channel of East Passage and Admiralty Inlet to the northwesterly corner of King County, Washington and true point of beginning.

Section 6. Transmission of Resolution. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the King County Board of Commissioners and to the Councils of the other cities and towns located within the said metropolitan area.
