A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND TO
INITIATE ANNEXATION PROCEEDINGS

TO: King County Commissioners
County-City Building
Seattle 4, Washington

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO HEREBY RESOLVE AS
FOLLOWS:

1: That the best interests and general welfare of the City of Kirkland will be served by annexation to the City of Kirkland of the hereinafter described territory contiguous to the City of Kirkland.

2: That the estimated number of voters residing in said area is 1900


3: That the City does hereby pray the calling of an election to be held among the qualified voters residing in said area upon the question of annexation to the City of Kirkland, and further, upon the proposition that all property within said area shall, upon annexation, be assessed and taxed at the same rate and on the same basis as the property presently within the City of Kirkland is assessed and taxed, to pay for any currently outstanding indebtedness of the City of Kirkland existing at the date of such annexation.

4: That the cost of such election shall be borne by the City of Kirkland.

5: That said area is situate in the County of King, State of Washington, is contiguous to the City of Kirkland, and is described as follows:


COMMENCING at that certain point on the present Kirkland City limits being the northwest corner of the intersection of 100th (18th Avenue in Kirkland) and 116th Avenue Northeast; thence southeasterly to the northwest corner of Section 4, Township 25 North, Range 5, E.W.M.; thence east along the north boundary line of said Section 4, Township 25 North, Range 5, E.W.M., to the northeast corner thereof, and its intersection with the centerline of 132nd Avenue Northeast; thence south along the centerline of 132nd Avenue Northeast to its point of intersection with the center line of Northeast 85th; thence west along the centerline of Northeast 85th to its point of intersection with the centerline of 116th Avenue Northeast; thence southwest to that certain point on the present easterly City limits of the City of Kirkland, being the southwest corner of said intersection; thence commencing westerly along said easterly City limits to the point of beginning.
