

RESOLUTION NO. 477

WHEREAS pursuant to the requirements of Chapter 195 of the 1961 Session Laws of the State of Washington, the City of Kirkland did prepare a comprehensive street program for the ensuing six years, AND,


WHEREAS pursuant further to said law, the City Council of the City of Kirkland did hold a public hearing on said comprehensive plan at 8:00 P.M. at the City Hall in Kirkland, Washington, on the 18th of December, 1961, AND


WHEREAS, there were no written or oral objections to the comprehensive plan as prepared by the City of Kirkland relative to the street program for the ensuing six years within the City of Kirkland, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO RESOLVE that the comprehensive plan as prepared by the City Engineer for the City of Kirkland, and as submitted to the City Council, be and the same is hereby adopted, public hearing being held on the same on the 18th day of December, 1961, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M., and there being no written or oral objections to said comprehensive plan,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of the said comprehensive street program for the ensuing six years, together with a copy of this Resolution be filed with the Director of Highways of the State of Washington.
