

RESOLUTION NO. 478

CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland has been advised that consideration is being given to the relocation of State Highway 2-D, and

WHEREAS the Washington Good Roads Association has prepared and proposed such a relocation, and

WHEREAS the economic and population growth of the area served by said State Highway would appear to justify and require such relocation, and

WHEREAS such proposed relocation would be to the best interests and welfare of the residents of the City of Kirkland, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND:


1. The City of Kirkland recommends the relocation of State Highway 2-D as proposed by the Washington Good Roads Association with construction priorities as follows:

- (1.) From Primary State Highway 1 west to 104th Avenue Northeast (Lake Street in Kirkland, Washington);
- (2.) 104th Avenue Northeast south to Brisky's Corner in Houghton, Washington;
- (3.) East from Brisky's Corner to Lake Sammamish.


2. The City of Kirkland requests of the State Legislature the passage of an appropriation for the necessary surveys required in connection with said relocation of State Highway 2-D.


