RESOLUTION NO. 486 OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND

WHEREAS, it appears that the public interest of the City of Kirkland would be served and that it is the desire of the property owner abutting on the hereinafter described portion of unopened street that said portion be vacated, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND:

1. That a public hearing be held to consider whether the public interest and general welfare of the City of Kirkland will be served by the vacation of that certain portion of unopened street situate in Kirkland, King County, Washington, and described as follows:

"That portion of Lake Avenue in BLEWETT'S 1st Addition to Kirkland, according to Plat recorded in Volume 6 of Plats, Page 82, in King County, Washington, described as follows: BEGINNING at the most southerly corner of Lot 1, Block 32 of said Plat; thence southwesterly along southwesterly extension of westerly margin of Mill Street (now 8th Street West) as shown on said Plat, a distance of 20 feet; thence northwesterly parallel to the southwesterly line of said Lot a distance of 20 feet to intersection with southerly extension of westerly line of Lots 2, 3 and 4, said Block 32, and true point of beginning of tract herein described; thence continuing westerly along said parallel line distance of 29.98 feet; thence northwesterly parallel to the westerly line of said Lots 2, 3 and 4, Block 32, distance of 9.48 feet; thence westerly at right angles a distance of 20 feet; thence southeasterly parallel to westerly line of said Lots 2,3 and 4, said Block 32 a distance of 42.18 feet; thence, northeasterly parallel to most southerly line of Block 33 in said Plat, a distance of 40.04 feet to intersection with southerly extension of the westerly line of Lots 2, 3 and 4, Block 32 of said Plat; thence northwesterly along said Block line extended distance of 12.69 feet to true point of beginning."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

2. That said public hearing be held before the Kirkland City Council, in its Chambers in the Kirkland City Hall, on January 21st, 1963, at 8 o'clock P.M.
