

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND:

WHEREAS, The Rector, Churchwardens and Vestrymen of St. John's Parish in the City of Kirkland, a Washington Corporation, has filed with the City of Kirkland a petition for vacation of 3rd Street South between First Avenue South and Second Avenue South, in Kirkland, King County, Washington, and

WHEREAS, in said petition the petitioners state that it is the owner of more than two-thirds of the property abutting on said portion of street, to-wit: Lot 32, Block 101, and Lots 33 to 35, Block 102, Burke & Farrar's Kirkland Business Center Addition Division No. 25, and Lots 5 to 8, Block 3, and the north 20 ft of Lot 2 and Lots 3 to 6 of Block 4, Loggie and Evans Addition, all per plats, recorded, records of King County, Washington, and

WHEREAS, said petition appears to be in proper form,

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND:

1: That pursuant to the requirements of RCW 35.79.010 et seq., a public hearing shall be held before the Kirkland City Council to consider whether the public interest and general welfare of the City of Kirkland will be served by the vacation of that certain portion of 3rd Street South in the City of Kirkland, King County, Washington, above described, and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Kirkland Planning Commission make investigation and report its findings and recommendations to the City Council at or before said public hearing, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said public hearing be held before the Kirkland City Council in its chambers in the Kirkland City Hall on the first day of April, 1963, at eight o'clock p.m.
