

RESOLUTION NO. 493

WHEREAS, it appears that the public interest of the City of Kirkland, Washington, would be served and it is the desire of the property owners abutting on the hereinafter described portion of unopened street that said portion be vacated, now, herefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND:

1. That a public hearing be held to consider whether the public interest and general welfare of the City of Kirkland will be served by the vacation of that certain portion of unopened street situate in Kirkland, King County, Washington, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at the SE corner of Lot 1, Block 32, Blewett's First Addition to Kirkland, according to the plat thereof, recorded in Volume 6 of Plats, Page 82, records of King County, Washington; thence continuing on the easterly line of said lot 1, as produced south  $43^{\circ}28'00''$  west, 17.54 ft; thence north  $89^{\circ}59'00''$  west, along a line parallel with and 30 ft north of the produced extension of the southerly line of Block 33, of said plat, a distance of 55.90 ft to an intersection with the center-line of Lake Ave of said plat; thence north  $1^{\circ}32'00''$  west along said center-line of Lake Ave in said plat a distance of 208.88 ft; thence north  $88^{\circ}28'00''$  east 40.00 ft to the NW corner of Lot 4, Block 32 of said plat; thence south  $1^{\circ}32'00''$  east along the westerly line of said block 32 a distance of 169.68 ft to the SW corner of Lot 1 of said Block 32; thence south  $46^{\circ}32'00''$  east along the southerly line of said Lot 1, a distance of 40.00 ft to the point of beginning.;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

2. That said public hearing be held before the Kirkland City Council in its Chambers in the Kirkland City Hall on February 18th, 1963, at 8 o'clock P. M.
