RESOLUTION NO. 497

WHEREAS, the Kirkland Police Department has, pursuant to statutory procedures required, sold at public sale certain unclaimed properties held by said Department, and


WHEREAS, said sale resulted in receipt by the City of Kirkland Current Expense Fund of \$ 490.05, less costs of said sale, and

WHEREAS, said amount is revenue received by said Fund in excess of anticipated revenues for the 1963 budgetary year, and


WHEREAS, the Kirkland Police Department is in dire need of a new camera to replace the camera presently in use by said Department, and in further need of adequate darkroom facilities, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland that the Kirkland Police Department be and it hereby is authorized to expend, first, for the purchase of a new camera to replace the cameras presently in use by said Department and, second, so far as then remaining funds are available, to provide for adequate darkroom facilities for said Department, the monies received in excess of anticipated revenues as a result of said sale of unclaimed properties, less costs of sale. Such expenditures not to exceed \$ 490.05 in total amount.
