RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON

WHEREAS, the voters of the City of Kirkland on October 6, 1964, did by majority vote approve the council manager form of municipal government for the City of Kirkland, and

WHEREAS, upon such approval by the voters Section 35.18.270 of the Revised Code of Washington requires the election of a new seven member city council to be elected at the next general municipal election or at an election to be specially held if no general municipal election will be held within one year, and

WHEREAS, the next general municipal election will not be held until November, 1967, and a special election is therefore required,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:
