Alley Vacation

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City of Kirkland signed by owners of interest in real property representing more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon the hereinafter described unopened alley, and

2) That said public hearing will be held before the Kirkland City Council in its chambers in the Kirkland City Hall on August 16, 1965, at 8:00 P.M.
