WHEREAS, petition has been filed with the City of Kirkland signed by owners of interest in real property representing more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon the hereinafter described street, and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has studied said vacation request and filed its recommendation with the City Council,

THE CITY OF KIRKLAND:



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, AND NOTICE OF HEARING:


2: That said public hearing will be held before the Kirkland City Council in its chambers in the Kirkland City Hall on March 21, 1965, at 8:00 P.M.
