

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO MAKE APPLICATION THROUGH THE INTERAGENCY COMMITTEE FOR OUTDOOR RECREATION FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN PARK ACQUISITION AND DEVELOPMENT

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to institute and carry through all steps necessary to request financial assistance through the Interagency Committee for outdoor recreation in conjunction with the general obligation bond issue authorized by the Council and to be presented to the voters of the City of Kirkland on September 20, 1966, for the acquisition and development of city parks.

2. The City Manager is specifically directed to make application through said agency as to priorities one and two of the City of Kirkland Master Park Plan: Central Waterfront Development, \$214,000.00, acquisition of a North Kirkland Community Park, \$72,320, and development of said park, \$33,720.

3. In making this direction the City Council is aware of the resulting imposition of additional maintenance and operation costs and will be prepared to meet this challenge.
