A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND TO THE WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAYS.


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the intersections of 116th Avenue N.E. and the Redmond-Kirkland Road, and 118th Avenue N.E. and the Redmond-Kirkland Road, constitute portions of the interchange between State Highway 405 and Secondary State Highway 901, and


WHEREAS, because of the heavy traffic flow through said intersections, the number of motor vehicle accidents there occurring has significantly increased, resulting in substantial property damage, personal injury and one human fatality,

NOW, THEREFORE, the State Highway Department and the State Highway Commission are requested and urged to make immediate study of said intersections, and to take all steps including installation of control devices and lights as such studies indicate to be necessary.

ADOPTED by unanimous vote of the Kirkland City Council in regular meeting on October 3rd, 1966.
