

RESOLUTION NO. 571

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, AND NOTICE OF HEARING ON STREET VACATION:

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City of Kirkland signed by owners of interest in real property representing more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon the hereinafter described unopened street, and,

WHEREAS, it appears that the public interest of the City of Kirkland, Washington, would be served by the vacation of said street, and

That portion of 18th Place, extending between Market Street and 1st Street, in the City of Kirkland, King County, Washington.
