WHEREAS the cities of Redmond, Kirkland and Houghton have previously appointed through their respective Mayors a committee for the establishment of a teen-age organization to be operated jointly by the respective cities, and

WHEREAS such organization has been formed and extensive work done towards forming a permanent facility for teen-age activities which was destroyed by fire in the Kirkland Civic Center, and

WHEREAS It is deemed to be in the mutual interest of the three cities involved, together with adjacent communities, to encourage the continuation of the organization as established for teen-age activities, and

WHEREAS the teen-age organization has available to it substitute facilities at the Saint John's Episcopal Church in the City of Kirkland which will involve a monthly financial commitment;

BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY OF KIRKLAND does hereby commit not more than \$150.00 monthly, begining September 1, 1967 to the Teen-age center as one-third (1.3) of the contemplated cost of operation thereof for the remainder of 1967.
