

RESOLUTION No. 601

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND,
REQUESTING AND URGING THE MUNICIPALITY OF METROPOLITAN SEATTLE
TO EXTEND THE EAST SIDE TRUNK LINE.

WHEREAS, an undeveloped area, lying partly within the City limits of Kirkland, and partly within the area under King County state Highway No. 405, is in dire and urgent need of sewers, and proper improvement and development within said area cannot take place until sewers are available, and

WHEREAS, the development of undeveloped areas depends upon the availability of sanitary sewers and

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Municipality of Seattle, commonly known as METRO has followed a policy of not extending trunk-line sewer facilities into an area until it was improved and developed,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:


Section 1. The Council for the Metropolitan Municipality of Seattle, commonly known as METRO, is requested to review its policy in particular as to the area hereinabove referred to, and to consider a change of policy to extend the gravity facility to the location of N. E. 116th Street and Interstate Highway 405 prior to the complete development and improvement of that area, and the City Council of the City of Kirkland urgently requests that the gravity portion of the East Side trunk be so extended at the earliest possible time to allow orderly development of the area.

ADOPTED by majority vote of the Kirkland City Council in regular meeting on the 1st day of APRIL, 1968.
