

RESOLUTION NO. 607

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM THE WATER-SEWER DEPARTMENT TO THE CURRENT EXPENSE FUND TO PAY FOR IMPROVEMENT OF THE OLD SEWER TREATMENT SITE AS A PARKING LOT FOR CITY HALL.

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland heretofore sold to the municipality of Metropolitan Seattle its sewer treatment plant, retaining the site therefor, and,

WHEREAS, it has been the intention of the City and the City Council to improve said site as a parking lot adjoining the Kirkland City Hall, and to pay for the cost of improvement thereof, out of the proceeds received from Metro, and,

WHEREAS, said proceeds were heretofore deposited into the Water-Sewer Fund without first deducting therefrom the estimated cost of said parking lot improvement, and,

WHEREAS, it is now estimated the cost of improvement will be approximately Twelve-THOUSAND - Dollars,

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

1. The Director of Administration and Finance is hereby directed to transfer from the Metro proceeds account in the Water-Sewer Fund to the parking lot construction account in the current expense fund the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars to be used for payment of the improvement of the former treatment plant site as a parking lot in accordance with the plans and specifications on file in the office of the Director of Public Services.
