

RESOLUTION NO. 2024

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND FINDING REMOVAL OF OVERHEAD UTILITY FACILITIES WITHIN LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 101 TO BE IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST AND FOR THE PUBLIC BENEFIT.

WHEREAS, public hearing was held by the Kirkland City Council pursuant to RCW 35.96.050 in regular meeting on March 3, 1969 to consider the written objection timely filed to the removal of overhead utility facilities within said improvement district, and

WHEREAS, the Council did then determine that removal of all the overhead electrical facilities and service lines within Local Improvement District No. 101 to be in the public interest and for the public benefit, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Removal of all the overhead electrical and communication utility facilities including service lines within Local Improvement District No. 101 is in the public interest and for the public benefit.
