

RESOLUTION NO. 2030

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF ANNEXATION PROCEEDINGS: BRIDALWOOD CIRCLE.

WHEREAS, a notice of intention to commence annexation proceedings by property owners petition method was presented to the Kirkland City Council at its regular meeting April 21, 1969, and

WHEREAS, said notice was signed by property owners representing not less than ten percent of the assessed valuation of the proposed area to be annexed, and

WHEREAS, the City Council by motion set the date of April 28, 1969 for a special meeting to be held with the proponents of the annexation and other interested parties, and

WHEREAS, at such meeting the Council did consider the advisability of the proposed annexation and the question of assumption of existing City indebtedness as required by law and did also consider other matters relating to the proposed annexation of interest and concern to the City and the proponents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The City Council favors the proposed annexation of the territory described in the Notice of Intention to annex to the City of Kirkland.

*new.* Section 2. The area, if annexed to the City of Kirkland, shall **Not** be required to assume the existing general indebtedness of the City of Kirkland as of the effective date of the annexation. A statement regarding the decision of the City Council in regard to the assumption of existing City indebtedness stated clearly on each and every petition for annexation circulated within the area.

Section 3. A copy of this resolution shall be attached to each and every annexation petition to be circulated within the territory described in the notice of intention to commence annexation proceedings.
