

RESOLUTION NO. 2032

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Kirkland King County, Washington, has been informed that the Department of Highways of the State of Washington is considering the programming of a highway improvement project on a section of SSH 2-D State Highway No. 901 in Kirkland King County, said section being further described as follows:

SR 901 0.069 to 0.190 miles west of the junction of SR 405
(N.E. 53rd Street to N.E. 100th Street)

AND WHEREAS, the said Department of Highways further proposes that said improvement is to be financed from State Motor Vehicle Funds supplemented with Federal Aid Secondary Funds available to the State of Washington and reserved for use on the state highway system.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Kirkland, King County hereby concurs in the selection of the above described project. *as shown on Exhibit A (map)*

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be transmitted to the Washington State Highway Commission at Olympia, Washington.
