

RESOLUTION NO. 2035

A RESOLUTION of the City of Kirkland, Washington,  
employing counsel for certain services in  
connection with Local Improvement District No. 103  
of the City and the issuance of securities therefor.

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland, Washington, is contemplating  
the construction and installation of certain storm sewer and street  
improvements within the city and contemplates the creation of a local  
improvement district to provide the funds necessary to pay a portion  
of the cost of such improvements; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary and advisable that bond  
counsel be employed to prepare certain proceedings necessary for  
the creation of said proposed local improvement district and the  
issuance of warrants and bonds thereof, and to give their opinion as  
to the validity of such securities at the time of their issuance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of  
Kirkland, Washington, that Preston, Thorgrimson, Horowitz, Starin &  
Ellis, attorneys at law of Seattle, Washington, be and they are hereby  
employed to perform the services above set forth, and as compensation  
therefor, the city agrees to pay them the sum of \$1,150.00.

The city further agrees to furnish said counsel at their  
office in Seattle, Washington, with a complete certified transcript  
of all proceedings taken in the matter of the formation of said local  
improvement district and the issuance of said securities.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Kirkland, Washington,  
and approved by its Mayor at a regular meeting of said Council, held  
on the 16th day of June, 1969.
