RESOLUTION NO. 2038

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE COUNCIL TO ADOPT FOR THE CITY OF KIRKLAND THE CLASSIFICATION OF NONCHARTER CODE CITY, GOVERNED BY THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 35A.02 OF THE REVISED CODE OF WASHINGTON.

WHEREAS, there is now available to the City of Kirkland under the provisions of Chapter 35A.02 of the Revised Code of Washington, the classification of noncharter code city; and

WHEREAS, the Council feels that adopting such classification will serve the best interests and general welfare of the City; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That it will serve the best interest and general welfare of the of the City to change the classification of the City of Kirkland from that of a city of the third class, to that of a noncharter code city.

Section 2. That it is the intention of the Council to adopt for the City of Kirkland the classification of noncharter code city.

Section 3. That also, it is the intention of the Council to retain the plan of government under which the City is presently operating, to-wit: the Countil-Manager form of government.

Section 4. That the clerk is directed to publish this resolution at least once, in the Eastside Journal, a newspaper of general circulation within the City, within ten days after the passage hereof.

Section 5. That if no timely and sufficient referendum petition has been filed, as provided for in Section 35A.02.020, and as determined by R.C.W. 35A.29.170, within 90 days of the first publication hereof as aforesaid, that the Council shall by ordinance adopt for the City of Kirkland the classification of noncharter code city under the Council-Manager plan of government.
