

RESOLUTION No. 2040

IN THE MATTER OF PSH No. 1 (SR 405) Midlakes to Kirkland and PSH No. 1 (SR 405) Northrup Interchange to N. E. 140th, State of Washington Department of Highways;

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland is the holder of certain easement rights for water pipe line lying within the above-designated highways;

WHEREAS, these easement rights are abandoned and said water pipe line is no longer being used by the City of Kirkland;

WHEREAS, in the improvement of said above-designated highway by the State of Washington, Department of Highways, it is necessary and advisable for the State of Washington to obtain a Quit Claim Deed for the purpose of clearing the right of way to the satisfaction of the Bureau of Public Roads;

WHEREAS, after due consideration by the Council of the City of Kirkland, it appears to said Council that it will be in the best interest of both the City of Kirkland and the State of Washington that said Council convey said lands to the State of Washington by quit claim deed for mutual benefits;

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Council of the City of Kirkland, that the City of Kirkland, through its Council, execute said deed and deliver said deed to the State of Washington, Department of Highways.
