within the Kirkland Planning area, and


WHEREAS, following such review and study the

network of trails for public use.

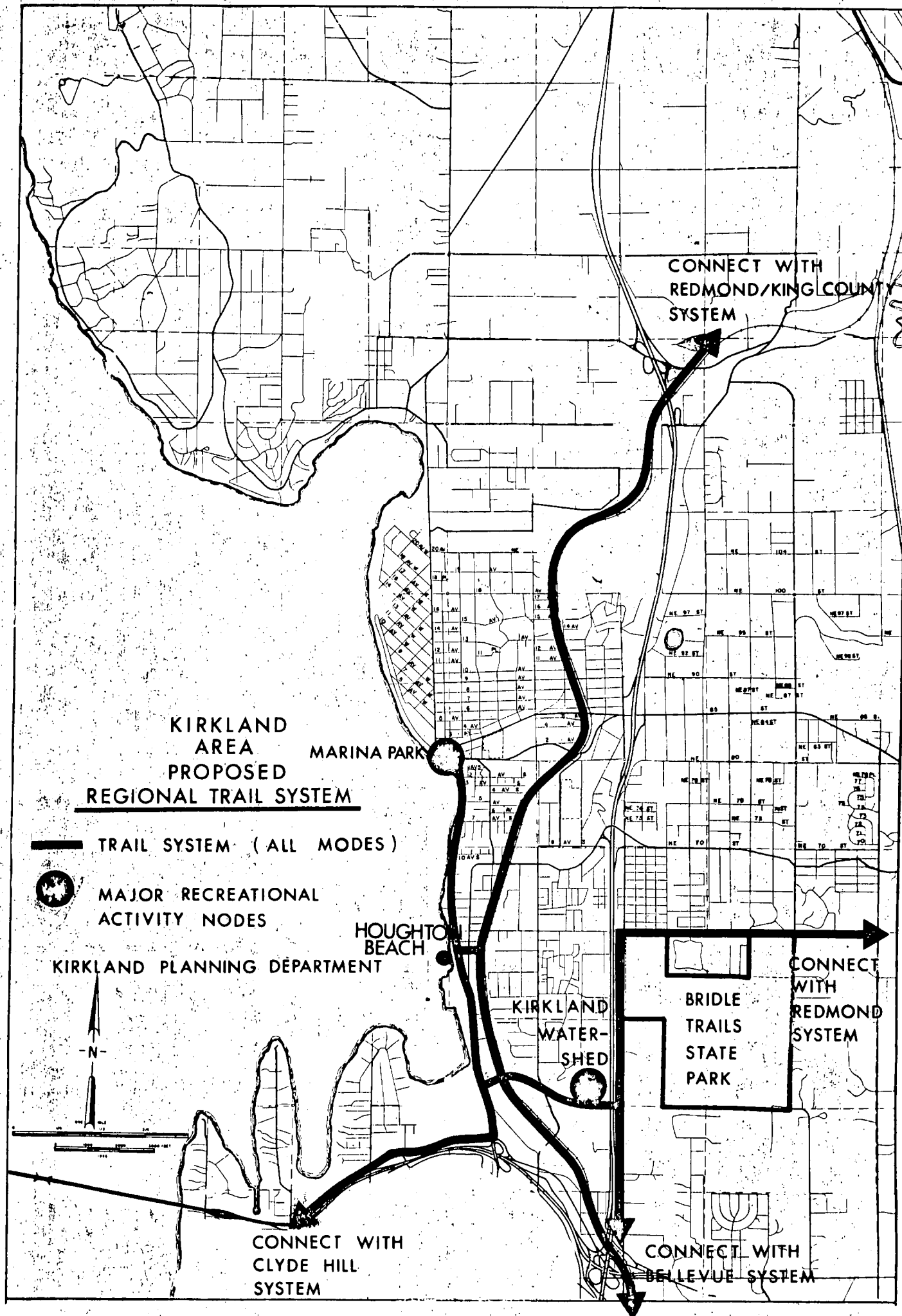

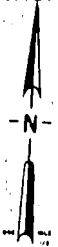


**KIRKLAND
