

RESOLUTION NO. 2057


A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO BUILDING PERMITS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF IMPROVEMENTS OVER SHORELANDS SUBMERGED BY THE WATERS OF LAKE WASHINGTON.

WHEREAS, there appears at the present time to be substantial doubt as to the right of a littoral or riparian owner to construct improvements over or on land submerged by the waters of a navigable lake other than in the direct aid of navigation, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:


Section 1. The City Manager and his staff, including the Building Department, are hereby instructed to withhold the issuance of any building permit for improvement over the submerged shorelands of Lake Washington until further direction of the City Council.

ADOPTED by majority vote of the Kirkland City Council in regular meeting on February 2, 1970.
