A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE ACCEPTANCE OF ASSIGNMENT OF LEASE.

WHEREAS, a portion of the pier recently acquired by the City of Kirkland from the Standard Oil Company, extends beyond the inner harbor line and into the area between the inner and outer harbor lines in Lake Washington, and

WHEREAS, said portion of said pier is subject to a harbor area (fresh water) lease between the Port of Seattle as lessor, and Standard Oil Company of California as lessee, which lease extends for a term ending March 31, 1977, and

WHEREAS, the Standard Oil Company of California has assigned its leasee interest to the City of Kirkland,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland, as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor of the City of Kirkland is hereby authorized and directed to sign on behalf of the City of Kirkland the lease assignment and acceptance thereof between Standard Oil Company of California and the City of Kirkland, a copy of which is attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein.
