

RESOLUTION NO. 2070

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND.

WHEREAS, the zoning Ordinance for the City of Kirkland requires that any private pier or wharf shall be set back a minimum of twelve feet from the side property line, except whereby mutual agreement of adjoining property owners, acknowledged as a Deed, and recorded with the King County Auditor, a pier or wharf may be built up to the common side line of the adjoining owner's property, and

WHEREAS, Grant J. Silvernale, Jr., and Nancy A. Silvernale, residents and property owners within the City of Kirkland, are owners of a private pier or wharf falling within the aforementioned requirement of the Kirkland Zoning Code, and


WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland is the adjoining property owner, and

WHEREAS, there appears to be no objection to entering into such a mutual agreement in regard to the "Silvernale" private pier,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:


Section 1. The Mayor, together with the Director of Administration and Finance, ex officio City Clerk, are hereby authorized and directed to enter into such a mutual agreement substantially in the form attached to this resolution as Exhibit A and incorporated hereby by this reference.
