## RESOLUTION NO. 2078

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DECLARING CERTAIN PROPERTY TO BE SURPLUSED, AND AUTHORIZING SALE OF SAME TO AN ADJOINING PROPERTY OWNER.

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland did heretofore purchase several contiguous lots in Vaux's Echo-Arms Addition No. 1, according to plat thereof, records of King County, Washington, for general municipal purposes, and

WHEREAS, the City did thereafter prepare and approve development and improvement plans for a substantial portion of said property as a neighborhood park, and

WHEREAS, the Park and Recreation Department, together with the Park Board, have recommended to the City that the unused portion of said property be declared surplus to the foreseeable needs of the City, and

WHEREAS, the owners of property adjacent to said surplus parcel have requested to purchase same,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The following described real property owned by the City of Kirkland and adjacent to Meatball Park is hereby declared to be surplus to the foreseeable needs of the City of Kirkland, to-wit:

That portion of Lot 11, Vaux's Echo-Arms Addition No. 1, recorded in Volume 52 of plats, page 29, Records of King County, Washington, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point of origin 45 ft and north 3°13'45" west from the southwest corner of Lot 11, thence S 3°13'45" east along the property line common to lot 7, thence north 86°46'15" east 40.36 ft along property line common with lot 7, thence north 45°06'41" west 60.45 ft to the point of origin.

Section 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to sign on behalf of the City its quitclaim deed to Dean C. Turpin and Barbara Turpin, his wife, as to the above-described property, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to deliver said quitclaim deed to said grantees upon such terms and conditions as are satisfactory to the City Manager and the Park Board. All costs incurred in connection with this conveyance are to be borne by the aforementioned grantees.
