

RESOLUTION NO. 2088

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, AND NOTICE OF HEARING ON STREET VACATION.

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City of Kirkland signed by owners of interest in real property representing more than two-thirds of the property abutting on the hereinafter described streets within the City of Kirkland, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the public interest of the City of Kirkland may be served by the vacation of said streets,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland:

1. That a public hearing be held to consider whether the public interest and general welfare of the City of Kirkland will be served by the vacation of those portions of streets situate in Kirkland, King County, Washington, and more particularly described as follows:

That portion of 14th Avenue North bounded on the north by Lot F, and bounded on the south by Lot G, all in supplementary plat of Central Addition to Kirkland, according to plat thereof, records of King County.

All of said street lies within the perimeter of the area designated by the Lake Washington School District as its replacement site for Central Elementary School.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND NOTICE OF HEARING:


2. That said public hearing will be held before the Kirkland City Council in its chambers at the Kirkland City Hall on April 19, 1971.
