

RESOLUTION NO. 2094
AND NOTICE OF HEARING ON INTENTION TO ANNEX

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to RCW 35A.14.295, et seq., the Kirkland City Council hereby resolves to annex the hereinafter described unincorporated territory being of less than 100 acres in size, and having at least 80% of the boundaries thereof contiguous to the City of Kirkland.

Section 2. The number of voters residing in said territory is estimated to be 0.

Section 3. If annexed, said territory shall be subject to the existing indebtedness of the City of Kirkland.

Section 4. If annexed, said territory shall be zoned in accordance with Ordinance No. 122(H) in effect within the Houghton Community, C-3.

Section 5. Public hearing on this proposed annexation shall be held before the Kirkland City Council in its chambers at the Kirkland City Hall at 8:00 P.M. on the 21st day of June, 1971. Any and all interested persons may appear and be heard.

Section 6. The area resolved to be annexed is described as follows:

Beginning at a point which is south 968.77 feet and west 879.49 feet from the north quarter corner of Section 20, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.M., in King County, Washington, "THE bearing of the east half of the north line of said Section 20 being north 89°07'12" east"; thence north 69°44'45" west 238.47 feet to an iron pipe marking the true point of beginning of this description; thence northerly 4°3'25" west 287.71 feet to an iron pipe; thence south 89°2'35" west to 165 feet to an iron pipe on the margin of the County road; thence southerly and south-easterly along said margin 230 feet, more or less, to an iron pipe which bears north 69°44'45" west of the true point of beginning; thence south 69°44'45" east 165 feet to the true point of beginning, LESS State Highway and LESS that portion lying southerly of a line running from a point 80 feet northerly of the southwest corner of the above described tract to a point 87 feet northerly of the southeast corner of said above described tract.
