

RESOLUTION NO. 2103

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND GRANTING TO THE CITY OF KIRKLAND A SHORELINE MANAGEMENT PERMIT FOR SUBSTANTIAL DEVELOPMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland has heretofore by Corps of Engineers permit application No. NPS-71-265 applied for a Corps of Engineers permit to construct at approximately the same location and as replacement for an existing 36-inch storm sewer outfall, a 72-inch concrete storm sewer outfall into Moss Bay of Lake Washington, all within the right of way of Market Street as said street extends into and under Moss Bay of Lake Washington, and

WHEREAS, approval for said construction has been received from the Department of Ecology, the Department of Fisheries and Game, and from the Corps of Engineers, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Fisheries and Game approval requires completion of said project by September 30, 1971, and

WHEREAS, said storm sewer outfall requires in addition a substantial development permit under the Shoreline Management Act, Chapter 286, Laws of 1971, First Ex. Sess., and

WHEREAS, said storm sewer development, including outfall, is consistent with and in furtherance of the comprehensive plans for development of the City of Kirkland, including the arterial and waterfront elements thereof and is a necessary part of the accelerated project for improvement of Market Street as funded by the Urban Arterial Board,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Shoreline Management Substantial Development Permit No. 1 of the City of Kirkland shall issue to the City of Kirkland for construction of a replacement 72-inch concrete storm sewer outfall, in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor set forth in the application of the City of Kirkland to the Seattle District Corps of Engineers under Public Notice No. NPS-71-265.

Section 2. In view of the time limitation imposed by the approval of the Departments of Fisheries and Game, it is requested that the Department of Ecology, having heretofore given approval for this project pursuant to the requirements of the Water Quality Standards Act, concur with the City of Kirkland in waiver of the 45-day delay of start of construction.
