

RESOLUTION NO. 2110

A RESOLUTION OF THE KIRKLAND CITY COUNCIL GRANTING TO LOUIS S. MARSH A LICENSE TO USE AND MAINTAIN THE PUMP, WATERLINE AND ELECTRICAL CONDUITS LOCATED WITHIN THE REAL PROPERTY DONATED TO THE CITY BY LOUIS S. MARSH.

WHEREAS, Louis S. Marsh has heretofore donated to the City of Kirkland certain real property lying along the shore line of Lake Washington, and

WHEREAS, there is presently located within said donated property a pump and waterline serving other real property owned by Louis S. Marsh, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of both Mr. Marsh and the City of Kirkland that he retain the use of said pump and waterline,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:


Section 1. There is hereby granted to Louis S. Marsh for the benefit of the real property now owned by him and lying between Lake Washington Boulevard and Lake-Vue Terrace immediately to the east of the hereinafter described real property, a license to use, maintain and repair (including replacement when necessary) the waterline and water pump, including electrical motor and electrical conduits, now existing within the hereinafter described real property, to-wit:

That portion of the following described property lying westerly of Lake Washington Boulevard Northeast as the same is now established:

The north 115 feet of the south 312 feet of Government Lot 3, Section 8, Township 25 North, Range 5 E.W.M., TOGETHER with shorelands of the second class lying between the westerly extensions of the north and south lines of said portion of Government Lot 3,


all within Kirkland, King County, Washington.
