

RESOLUTION NO. 2118

A RESOLUTION of the City Council of the City of Kirkland, Washington fixing the time and place for hearing upon the assessment roll for Local Improvement District No. 104.

WHEREAS, the assessment roll for Local Improvement District No. 104 has been prepared and filed with the City Clerk and the City Council now desires to fix the time and place for hearing thereon;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland, Washington, as follows:

Section 1. That Monday, March 20, 1972, at 8:00 o'clock in the evening in the Council Chambers at the City Hall, in the city of Kirkland, be and the same hereby is fixed as the time and place for hearing upon the assessment roll for Local Improvement District No. 104.

Section 2. That the City Clerk is hereby directed to give notice of the time and place of said hearing at least fifteen (15) days before the date fixed therefore by mailing to the owners, or reputed owners, of the property within Local Improvement District No. 104 whose names appear on the assessment roll at the addresses shown on the tax rolls of the County Treasurer and in addition thereto, to cause said notice to be published in two consecutive issues in the Eastside Journal, the last publication to be at least fifteen days before the date fixed for such hearing.
