

RESOLUTION No. 2129

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND A CONTRACT WITH PUGET SOUND POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY FOR THE UNDERGROUNDING OF ELECTRICAL FACILITIES WITHIN LAKE PLAZA PARKING LOT FROM INTERSECTION OF MARKET STREET AND CENTRAL WAY TO KIRKLAND AVENUE, BEING LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 104.

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland has, by Local Improvement District creation determined to convert the utility facilities within Lake Plaza Parking Lot from Intersection of Market Street and Central Way to Kirkland Avenue to underground facilities in connection with and as a part of the improvements ordered for Local Improvement District No. 104, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 35.96.040 the City is authorized to enter into a contract with Puget Sound Power & Light to perform the work incidental to such conversion of electrical facilities,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to sign on behalf of the City of Kirkland that certain contract between the City of Kirkland and Puget Sound Power and Light Company for the electrical portion of said underground conversion in the amount of \$15,162.00, a copy of which contract is attached hereto as Exhibit A and by this reference incorporated herein.
