RESOLUTION NO. 2135

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND THAT CERTAIN CONTRACT WITH KING COUNTY ENTITLED TRANSPORTATION SERVICES AGREEMENT, A COPY OF WHICH IS ATTACHED.

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

WHEREAS, the Kirkland City Council and the King County Council have found that the maintenance of public transit service available to suburban King County is urgently required pending voter approval and development of a County wide Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle Transit System, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council has authorized the County Execute to enter into a contract with the Metropolitan Transit Corporation to provide public transportation service to suburban King County, and

WHEREAS, the providing of public transportation service to suburban King County requires that the cost of such service be shared between King County and the various suburban cities on the basis of the residency of the ridership utilizing the contracted lines,

NOW, THEREFORE,

Section 1. The Kirkland City Council approves and authorizes the Mayor to sign on behalf of the City of Kirkland that certain agreement, a copy of which is attached to this Resolution and by reference incorporated herein, between King County and the City of Kirkland entitled Transportation Services Agreement.

TRANSPORTATION SERVICES AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made as of the 10th day of July 1972, between King County, State of Washington, and the City of Kirkland.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the King County Council has found that the Municipal ity of Metropolitan Seattle has been authorized by the legislature to undertake the function of public transit within King County subject to the approval of the people of two ballot measures authorizing and financing such function;

WHEREAS, the King County Council has found that the maintenance of public transit service available to suburban King County and southwest Snohomish County is urgently required pending development of the county-wide Metro system;

WHEREAS, the King County Council has found that the Metropolitan Transit Corporation operates the only public transit
service presently available in suburban King County and southwest
Snohomish County;

WHEREAS, the King County Council has authorized the County Executive to enter into a contract with the Metropolitan Transit Corporation to provide public transportation service to suburban King County and southwest Snohomish County;

WHEREAS, the providing of public transportation service to suburban King County and southwest Snohomish County requires that the cost of such service be shared between King County and the various suburban cities and Snohomish County on the basis of the residency of the ridership utilizing the contracted lines.

NOW, THEREFORE, King County and the City of Kirkland hereby agree as follows:

(1) SERVICES AND PAYMENT: In consideration of the services to be provided by Metropolitan Transit Corporation pursuant to that certain management contract heretofore entered into between King County and the Metropolitan Transit Corporation, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and by this reference

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incorporated into and made a part hereof, the City of Kirkland shall pay to King County 14.0% of the sum payable per month for the period of July 1, 1972 to December 31, 1972, if any, to Metropolitan Transit Corporation by King County in accordance with the terms and conditions of the above-referenced contract (Exhibit "A"). The Payment due King County pursuant to this paragraph shall be computed monthly as of the last day of each month and shall be due and payable on or before the 25th day of the following month.

- (2) CONTRACT PERIOD AND CANCELLATION CLAUSE: This contract is for the period commencing on July 1, 1972 and ending on December 31, 1972. Further, this contract may be cancelled by either party upon thirty (30) days written notice.
- (4) CONTINGENT: This contract is expressly contingent upon the performance of that certain management contract heretofore entered into between King County and Metropolitan Transit Corporation. If said management contract is not fully performed in accordance with its terms and conditions or if terminated in accordance with Paragraph VIII thereof, this contract shall fail and be of no effect.
- (5) NOTICES: Any notice, request, instruction or other document to be given hereunder to any party shall be in writing, delivered personally or sent by registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, as follows: if to King County, to John D. Spellman, 400 King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington 98104, and if to the City of Kirkland, to Mr. Allen B. Locke, City Mgr., 200 Main Street, Kirkland, Washington 98033. Any party may

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change its address for purposes of this paragraph by giving written notice of such change of address to the other party in the manner herein provided for giving notice.

(6) COUNTERPARTS: This agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which when so executed shall be an original, but such counterparts shall together constitute but one and the same instrument.
