RESOLUTION NO. 2145 OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND NOTICE OF HEARING ON STREET VACATION.

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City of Kirkland signed by owners of interest in real property representing more than two-thirds of the property abutting on the hereinafter described streets and alleys within the City of Kirkland, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the public interest of the City of Kirkland, Washington, may be served by the vacation of said streets, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland:

1. That a public hearing be held to consider whether the public interest and general welfare of the City of Kirkland will be served by the vacation of those portions of streets situate in Kirkland, King County, Washington, and described as follows:

- (a) The North 30 feet of N.E. 68th bordering Lots 15 - 20, Block 8, Cormode & Adsits First Addition, a distance of 178.6 feet.
- (b) The South 30 feet of the 179.192 feet of N.E. 69th Street, adjacent to Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and the East 22 feet of Lot 6 in Block 8 of Cormode and Adsit's First Addition of Kirkland.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND NOTICE OF HEARING:


2. That said public hearing will be held before the Kirkland City Council in its chambers at Kirkland City Hall on October 16, 1972, at 8:00 P.M.
