


RESOLUTION NO. 2150

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND WASHINGTON FIXING THE TIME AND PLACE OF A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE FINAL ASSESSMENT ROLL OF LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 108 AND DIRECTING NOTICE THEREOF BE GIVEN IN THE MANNER REQUIRED BY LAW.

WHEREAS, the final assessment roll for Local Improvement District No. 108 which was created and established by Ordinance No. 2189 passed by the City Council and approved by the Mayor on June 19, 1972 has been prepared as provided by law and is on file with the Director of Administration and Finance (ex officio City Clerk) and it is necessary to fix a date for public hearing thereon before the City Council.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland, Washington that the public hearing on the final assessment roll for Local Improvement District 108 for the installation of a street lighting system, together with an underground electric distribution system and an underground telephone system to replace the present overhead systems along Market Street and Central Way from N.E. 106th Street South on Market Street to its intersection with Central Way and then East on Central Way to the intersection of Central Way and Third Street shall be held before the City Council at 8:00 o'clock P.M. (P.D.S.T.) on October 16, 1972 in the Council Chambers of the City Hall of the City and notice of such public hearing both by mailing and publication as required by law shall be given.

ADOPTED by the City Council and approved by the Mayor of the City of Kirkland, Washington at its regular meeting thereof this 18th day of September, 1972.
