RESOLUTION NO. 2165 OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND NOTICE OF HEARING ON STREET VACATION.

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City of Kirkland signed by owners of interest in real property representing more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon the hereinafter described street, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the public interest of the City of Kirkland, Washington, would be served by the vacation of said street.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland:



Westerly 20 feet of 114th Ave. N.E. for a distance of 230 feet south from intersection of 114th N.E. and N.E. 65th Street.
