
A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND ENDORSING THE METRO POLICY STATEMENT.

WHEREAS the Kirkland City Council endorsed the ballot measure put to the voters on September 19, 1972, to create a county-wide transit system;

WHEREAS the City Council made that endorsement with the understanding that the dollars raised in King County by the levy of an additional .3% in the retail sales tax would be matched by the State of Washington on a dollar-for-dollar basis;


THEREFORE, be it resolved that: the Kirkland City Council approves and endorses the statement of policy adopted by the Metro Council on Monday, April 2, at an emergency meeting, calling on the state to keep its promise of long-term funding assistance for local transit systems.
