

RESOLUTION NO. 2178

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND  
NOTICE OF HEARING FOR PEDESTRIAN-WALKWAY VACATION.

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City of Kirkland signed by owners of interest in real property representing more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon the hereinafter described walkway, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the public interest of the City of Kirkland, Washington, would be served by the vacation of said walkway.

Tract "E", Bridle Tree No. 2


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND NOTICE OF HEARING:
