

RESOLUTION NO. 2183

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND FINDING REMOVAL OF OVERHEAD UTILITY FACILITIES WITHIN LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 104 (LAKE PLAZA PARKING LOT) TO BE IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST AND FOR THE PUBLIC BENEFIT, AND DIRECTING THE REMOVAL OF SAID OVERHEAD FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the Kirkland City Council by Resolution No. 2164 adopted the 5th day of February, 1973, did give notice to all owners of property located within Local Improvement District No. 104 to convert their electrical and communication facilities from overhead to underground within 90 days, and

WHEREAS, the time for objection to the removal of said overhead facilities or any part thereof has expired,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Removal of all of the overhead electrical and communication utility facilities, including service lines, within Local Improvement District No. 104 (Lake Plaza Parking Lot) is in the public interest and for the public benefit.

Section 2. Puget Sound Power and Light Company and General Telephone Company are hereby ordered and directed to remove all of the existing overhead electrical and communication utility facilities, including service lines, within Local Improvement District No. 104.
