RESOLUTION NO. 2192 OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND NOTICE OF HEARING.
FOR STREET VACATION, BRIDLE TREE #3, FILE NO. V-73-32.

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City of Kirkland signed by owners of interest in real property representing more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon the hereinafter described street, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the public interest of the City of Kirkland, Washington, would be served by the vacation of said street.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland:

1) That a public hearing be held to consider whether the public interest and general welfare of the City of Kirkland will be served by the vacation of that street situate in Kirkland, King County, Washington, and described as follows:

1. The east 1/2 of 118th Ave. N.E. lying between the southerly margin of N.E. 70th Street and the centerline of N.E. 69th Street.
2. The north 1/2 of N.E. 69th Street lying between the easterly margin of 118th Ave. N.E. and the westerly margin of 119th Ave. N.E.
3. That portion of the west 1/2 of 119th Ave. N.E. bounded by the southerly margin of N.E. 70th Street on the north, the centerline of N.E. 69th Street on the south and on the east by a line lying 50.00 feet westerly of and parallel to the easterly margin of 119th Ave. N.E. in the plat of Bridle Tree No. 2 as recorded in Volume 95 on pages 22 and 23 records of King County, Washington.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND NOTICE OF HEARING:

2) That said public hearing will be held before the Kirkland City Council in its chambers in the Kirkland Council Building on July 16, 1973, at 8:00 P.M.
