## RESOLUTION NO. 2203

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND NOTICE OF HEARING FOR STREET VACATION, BRIDLE TREE NO. 4, FILE NO. V-73-35.
