

RESOLUTION NO. 2225

A RESOLUTION OF THE KIRKLAND CITY COUNCIL ACCEPTING THE REDUCED GRANT FROM THE WASHINGTON STATE INTERAGENCY COMMITTEE FOR OUTDOOR RECREATION AS TO THAT CERTAIN IAC PROJECT AGREEMENT: MARSH PARK DEVELOPMENT PROJECT NO. 73-059D.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation procedure and rules, the City of Kirkland heretofore presigned a contract with IAC in connection with IAC Project Marsh Park Development: IAC No. 73-059D prior to consideration of said project at the IAC meeting held on October 29 and 30, 1973, and

WHEREAS, at said meeting the IAC Grant for participation in said park development project was approved, but at a lesser percentage contribution by the IAC than contemplated in said contract and letter to the City from the IAC dated September 28, 1973, and

WHEREAS, the City and the City Council have reconsidered said project in the light of the reduced IAC Grant,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:


Section 1. The reduced Grant to the City from the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation of the State of Washington from the contemplated funding of 75% to the Grant award of 50% approved and authorized by the IAC at its meeting on October 29 and 30, 1973, is acceptable to the City. Said Grant having a dollar figure of \$40,812.50.

PASSED by a majority vote of the Kirkland City Council in regular meeting on the 3rd day of December, 1973.
